



Dripping Springs Drumline Contest Information

Performance Schedule Your performance schedule is enclosed. All drumlines will have a 30 minute warm up with a 10 minute travel time to the gate and a 5 minute ready time at the gate. **If you wish to warm up on your own before your scheduled time you may do so anywhere in front of the building.** This is first come first serve!!!!!!

Parking Please have your buses/trucks enter the far west entrance past the tennis courts. The bus and equipment parking lot is directly north of the stadium. Warm up areas A, B, and C are on the east side of the building. General parking lots are marked on your enclosed map.

Map A map of the contest zone and directions for entering Dripping Springs are enclosed.

Check In Station The Check In Station will be located in the bus/truck lot right beside the concession stand. You can get hands stamped, meet your guides, pay entry fees (if needed) and drop off announcer's sheets.

Drumline Entrance/Exit All drumlines will enter the stadium behind the home side bleachers for their performance. After the performance, they will exit on the North end or to the left. **See enclosed flow map for proper pit setup.**

Timing Each group will have 15 minutes to setup, perform, and exit the field.

Dressing You will need to dress at your buses. There are only two bathrooms at the stadium.

Post Performance You may come in and watch the rest of the groups on the home side. Please sit to the outside so our spectators may get a good seat.

Contest Results Unit reps will receive their comment sheets, tapes, and videos during the awards presentation.

Award Ceremony At the end of the contest, all unit representatives will be called to assemble behind the home side bleachers for retreat. Unit reps will then walk into the stadium and line up on the front sideline for the awards presentation.
